Tests can be shared with external users who do not have a BrainCert user account using "shareable link" feature. This can be used to create unique links and shared via email to students, or can be embedded into your website. You can also charge students for the test and collect payments.

Create shareable link

In your test options, click on the "Get shareable link".



Click "Create link" button to get started.

Start with a name for the link, time zone and availability date/time to set a specific date availability range.



You can allow "unlimited" attempts or limit it to only specific number of attempts by a student.



Now, you have options to password protect the test and also log test takers IP address.



When student click on "Home" and other links on the test can be redirected back to your website using "Redirect URL" feature.



Copy shareable link

To copy the test link, simply click on the link icon to open the popup.



Click the blue link icon to copy it to the clipboard.



Under "options", use the tick icon to publish or unpublish the shareable link. "Edit" and "delete" options are available as well.



Students view

Students are required to type in their name, email and other details to start the test. You can track this info and test result in your "Reports" dashboard.



Upcoming tests are shown with a countdown timer with a pleasing landing page design.
